SHB(GB) AFFILIATED RIDDEN HUNTERS ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW (RIHS) QUALIFYING CLASSES

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2024 Society's Rules.

Classes 2 - 8 & 36 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2024 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed Horses in classes 2 – 8 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No Horse lower than second in its Class will qualify. In the Working Hunter Class, the three highest placed horses will qualify, or in the case of two Working Hunter Classes (i.e. Lightweight and Heavyweight) the four horses forward for the Championship will qualify. No horse lower than third in its Class will qualify.

Day Ticket = £42 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £42 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). Should you qualify for the Royal International Horse Show on a Day Ticket, you must apply for full annual membership for the owner/rider and horse by completing and submitting to the Society's office Membership and Show Registration application forms. Applications must be received in this office within 14 days from the day you qualified in order for your qualification to be validated. If your horse does not have a passport issued by SHB(GB) you will also need to have your horse's passport overstamped.

Competitors in classes 2 – 8 & 36. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats. Hat standards accepted as of 1st January 2024 are as follows: PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards.

This does not apply to Novice Working Hunter classes. Any Horse that qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show in a Ridden Hunter class (not including Working Hunter classes) will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but Horses that qualified for the Horse of the Year Show as a 4 year old are exempt.

THE BRITISH HORSE FEEDS AND IDHS (GB) RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES

This show is a qualifier for the British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series. The 3 highest-placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 9 and 10 will qualify for the final to be held at the Royal International Horse Show **Hickstead, on July 27^{th,} 2024.** Qualification can be passed to 4th place if the highest-placed horses have already qualified and if in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality. Purebred Irish Draught horses must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB). Purebred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class1 Class 2, or RID(GB). Owners of Pure Bred Irish Draught horses must be FULL members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB). Irish Draught Sport Horses (including stallions) must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. Owners do not have to be members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB). All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over. N.B. Stallions MUST be ridden and handled by an experienced person over the age of 18 and identified by a white and red tail ribbon (there are many grey ID and IDSH)

- 3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors, Riders or their Horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
- 5. While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
- 6. Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs, Riding Horses and Hunters which have not won a first prize of £25 or more or a total of £150 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a 4 year old are exempt unless the animal has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £25 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle
- 7. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst riding and leading horses on the showground.
- 8. DOGS are allowed on the Showground but MUST be kept on a lead any dog fouling must be cleaned up.

Novice Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob, Riding Horse and Hunters: A Novice is a Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse that has not won a first prize of £25 or more, or more than a total of £150 (including any Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Home Produced Novice, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle, or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings as a 4 year old are exempt, unless that 4 year old has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £25 or more. If the category has changed from a Hack to a Riding Horse or vice versa, it may not revert back to a Novice. Snaffle bridles may be worn for Novice classes. Novice animals must be Registered with the Association or Exhibitors must have purchased a 'Day Ticket' in order to compete in Novice classes (unless otherwise stated in the schedule). Animals which have been placed in the top five at either the Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show in any OPEN ridden class, BSHA or otherwise, with the exception of the Search for a Star finals or, are ineligible to compete in Novice Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse classes. Horses competing in Novice classes must be ridden by the Judge, before being asked to "strip" for conformation. Novice status remains for all competitors placed and presented with prize money in ANY Rising Star classes or Finals.

Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes: Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. BSHA Registration numbers must be quoted on Entrymaster when entering. The Royal International Horse Show: The First Prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Direct Qualifiers for Finals at London International Horse Show (LIHS December 2024): The highest placed unqualified in top 5 to qualify. Available to competitors within these classes is the Rising Star Rulebook 2024, available on the Association website at www.britishshowhorse.org No competitor previously deemed a showing Professional / Producer, may be permitted to enter these classes.

JMB certificates will not be required to compete in these classes.

The Judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes.

Turley & Gill Amateur Home Produced Qualifier: Owners, Riders and Horses must be registered with BSHA or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Riders must be 15years of age or older. This class is a qualifier for the Turley & Gill Family Amateur Home-Produced Supreme Final to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. Open to horses to be Home-Produced and ridden by an Amateur; please see rule 7 in 2024 BSHA Rulebook for Amateur Home-Produced definition. Horses must be registered as a either a Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse. The two highest placed unqualified in the top five will qualify for the final at the BSHA National Championship Show.

BSHA SUPREME OF THE YEAR: The 1st or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA SUPREME OF THE YEAR FINAL for Hacks, Cobs, Riding Horses, Maxi Cobs and Hunters, if they are registered with the BSHA or have purchased a Day Ticket for the Championship Show, in which case their membership will be accepted by the BSHA Office for the National Championship Show. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2024. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and RIHS Hunter classes).

SPORTS HORSE BREEDING CLASSES: All SHB(GB) Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2024 Society's Rules. Classes 2-8, 36 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2024 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter at the RIHS. In the Working Hunter Class the three highest placed horses will qualify or in the case of two Working Hunter Classes (i.e. Lightweight and Heavyweight) the four horses forward for the Championship will qualify. No horse lower than second in its Class will qualify. The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final.

Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024. Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st, 2023. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.
