

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY

Classes 1-5, 10-12, 18-21, 23, 27-29, 51-52, 62, 67-68 & 73 & 74 are qualifying Classes for the **Royal International Horse Show**. Only one pony from each class qualifies, and the highest placed (not already qualified), from the first 3 ponies in each class will qualify. All ponies in these classes must be owned, registered, and ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, and animals must be registered with the A.H.S. to compete in classes 73 and 74. This Show is a qualifier for the **BSPS Championships Show**.

LR, FR, Open Show Ponies, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Open W.H.P.s, Open S.H.P.s, LR of Hunter Type, Open Intermediates, Open Heritage LR, FR, W.H.P.

B.S.P.S. "BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" RIDER OF THE YEAR

B.S.P.S. "BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" BEST RIDER

B.S.P.S. "Black Country Saddles" Best Rider competitions for riders 25 years and under will be at All B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows with a final at the B.S.P.S. Summer Championships. For further details contact your Area Chairman.

Ponies placed 1st in BSPS Open Classes will qualify for the BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket (Amateur & Novice classes only). Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes 40-46 are qualifying classes for the Royal International Horse Show. The first in each class will qualify if 1st has already qualified 2nd will qualify. If 1st & 2nd have already qualified, then 3rd will qualify. The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2024.

Horses competing in Sport Horse Breeding classes of (GB) classes at affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack & Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse Classes.

DAY TICKETS

Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the young rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship show in September 2024.

SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

The Show is affiliated to the S.H.B.(G.B.) and competitors are REQUIRED to abide by its 2024 rules and regulations. Please refer to the SHB(GB) Rule Book. Owners, Riders and Producers of horses competing in RIHS classes run in accordance with Sport Horse Breeding of GB must be a member of the society.

Prize Money for RIHS SHB (GB) Classes 31-36) is 1st £25

Day tickets = £42 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show in the year- it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days.

Amateur Rules – including Amateur Working Hunter

It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules. The Directors / Board / Council reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary. AMATEUR STATUS

A person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

- Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing, or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income.
- Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to; riding schools, events centre, stud, or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of

an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.

• Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, SHB(GB) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. PLEASE NOTE:

If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/Council, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional.

A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in ANY class, SHB(GB) or otherwise,

with the exception of Working classes, Side Saddle classes AND Novice classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.

The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership). On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.

No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during Amateur classes (including Amateur Home Produced), this applies to equines, riders and any attendees; this also includes outside the ring, or online i.e. on social media. We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes.

1. AMATEUR CLASSES

- a). AMATEUR OWNER / RIDER: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- b). AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes.

BRITISH SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD ASSOCIATION

Classes 69 - 72 are affiliated to the British Skewbald & Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead and the BSPA WCC. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules – download from www.bspaonline.com. All horses / ponies must be registered and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Rider's age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies

153cms and under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. All stallions must be graded with BSPA and in possession of a BSPA stallion ID card which must be carried at all times and produced on request. All stallions must wear a 2024 Blue BSPA Stallion disc. No rider under 15 may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2024 membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. Skewbald & Piebald horses / ponies only. Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for the Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship finals to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championships at College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. UK PONIES & HORSES RIHS YOUNG RIDERS /AMATEUR RIDERS

UK PONIES & HORSES ASSOCIATION – The 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed competitors will qualify for the Gold Medal Series at the 2024 UKPH Summer Classic, Equifest 2024 & BSPA 2024.

No membership is required to enter or compete in any Championship Final. Results will be verified by the Office.

Classes 58 -61 A06 UKPH Young Riders RIHS Ridden M&M. Class 62 A09 UKPH Amateur Riders RIHS Ridden M&M.

Owners must be Adult/Life Members. Riders must be current UKPH Members and the ponies currently be registered with UKPH before time of entry to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding,4 years old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland,New Forest, Shetland, WelshA,B,C or D. The highest placed competitor up to 5th place in each class qualify for the UKPH RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden and the UKPH RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at RIHS Hickstead (July 2024). QUALIFICATION WILL BE VERIFIED BY THE OFFICE

UKPH MM CHAMPIONSHIP

(A) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season: (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. (ii) Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or Riding School (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the

suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets. (iii)Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt and for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment. (iv)Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person, in any showing classes, UKPH or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. (v) A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, UKPH or otherwise, except for Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year or the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership. (vi)No person included on any Affiliated Judging Panel can compete in a UKPH Amateur class. UKPH feel that this is not entering into the spirit of the competition. (vii)On the day when an Exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals are not allowed to ride or work-in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.(B) Amateur Owner/Rider. Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. (C) Amateur Home Produced. Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January 2024, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in classes whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution & Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures of the BSPS and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.
- 3. The Show will be under the management of the Committee which will have the power to adjudge any dispute. The decision will be final.
- 4. The Committee will not be responsible for or liable for any loss or damage which exhibits pertaining to or connected with any exhibitor may sustain at the Show neither will the Committee be accountable in any way for accidents that may occur to any person attending the Show.
- 5. Please note that times given in the timetable are approximate and competitors must accept that times could alter.
- 6. NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES
- 7. NO entries refunded for ANY REASON, including lameness.
