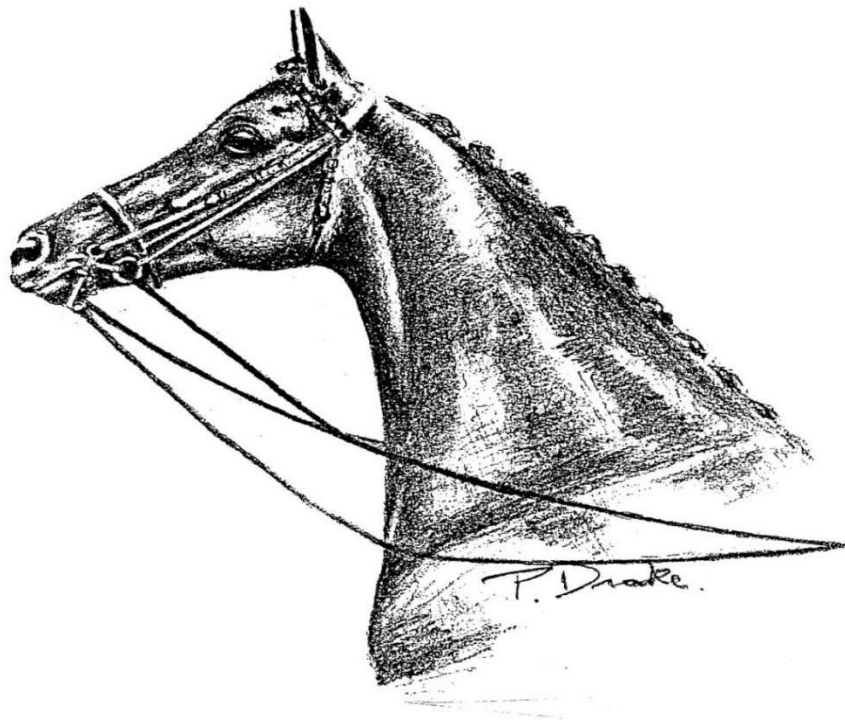

Ring 1

JUDGE –

Class 1 – BSPS Novice 133cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 2 – BSPS Novice 143cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 3 - BSPS Novice 153cm WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 4 - BSPS Novice Intermediate WHP mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

BSPS NOVICE WHP CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 – 4.

Class 5 – BSPS Mixed Height Open W.H.P Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders **MUST** jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride up to two ponies in the same height section (see rule 37). Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms. or the Intermediate Section.

JUDGE – Ms V Smith (Lancashire) and Mrs R Abba

Class 6 - BSPS RIHS Nursery Stakes. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini WHP Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 6, 13, 14, 15 & 16.

Pony, owner and rider need to be registered with the BSPS to compete in the Royal International Classes.

Class 7 - BSPS RIHS Open Working Hunter Pony. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 8 - BSPS RIHS Open Working Hunter Pony. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 9 - BSPS RIHS Open Working Hunter Pony. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 10 - BSPS RIHS Intermediate Working Hunter. Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Please note rule 201a – Riders must have competed in at least two qualifying rounds for Royal International Horse Show before competing at the final at the Royal International Horse Show.

RIHS WHP Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 7 – 10.

JUDGE – Ms V Smith (Lancashire)

Class 11a - BSHA RIHS Working Show Horse: Open ONLY to Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms. This class is NOT open to Hunters, i.e. those horses registered and competing as a hunter with BSHA, Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain or The Showing Register for the current season. Please see rule 2 iv in BSHA 2024 Rulebook.

Class 11 - Unaffiliated Novice Working Hunter. Mare, Gelding or Stallion, (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) 4 years old and upwards not having won a total of £100 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any W.H. class, excluding championship prize money or more than 5 BE Eventing points or £200 BS Show-jumping at home or equivalent before 1st Jan in the current year. Fences in Novice WH classes should be a min. of 0.85m (2'9") and a max of 3'3".

Class 12 – RIHS Working Hunter (run under SHB(GB) 2024 rules). Mare Gelding or Stallion (a competing stallion must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), exceeding 148CM. (14.2 hh approx.), 4 years old and over. The maximum total points available is 100. This is made up of: Jumping points=Max 40 points, Style & Presence whilst Jumping=Max 20 points, Ride/Manners=Max 20 Points,

Conformation=Max 20 points Fences a max. 3'9" a minimum of 8 and maximum of 12 at the Judges discretion. No change of tack or rider between phases. Boots of a dark colour may be worn during the jumping phase only. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st Jan in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. SEE WORDING IN 2024 SHB(GB) MEMBERS BOOK. **YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF SHB(GB) TO COMPETE IN THIS CLASS AND YOUR HORSE MUST BE ON THE 2024 REGISTER & IF DOES NOT HAVE A SHB(GB) PASSPORT THEN HORSES CURRENT PASSPORT NEEDS TO BE OVERSTAMPED OR CAN COMPETE ON A SHB(GB) DAY TICKET.**

Horse Worker Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 11a, 11 & 12.

JUDGE – Ms V Smith (Lancashire)

Class 13 - Unaffiliated LR WHP. Ponies not exceeding 122cms.

Class 14 – BSPS Tiny Tots Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Open to plaited or unplaited ponies.

Class 15 - BSPS Cradle Stakes. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. This is not a Winter qualifying class. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 16 - BSPS Open (Challenge) Nursery Stakes. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

JUDGE –

Class 17 – BSPS Heritage Cradle Stakes. Registered Purebred Ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 18 – BSPS Heritage Nursery Stakes. Registered Purebred Ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

BSPS Mini Heritage WHP Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 17 & 18.

Class 19 - BSPS Novice Heritage WHP Mixed Height Registered purebred ponies 4 years old or over. Riders of any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are in different height sections.

Class 20 - BSPS Open (Challenge) Heritage WHP. Mixed Height Registered purebred ponies 4 years old or over. Riders of any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride up to two ponies in the same height section (see rule 37).

Heritage WHP Championship - 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 19 & 20.

JUDGE –

Class 21 - 60cm Winter Worker Stakes Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland Ponies 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed child under 12yrs of age on 1st January in the current year in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships

Class 22 - 70cm Winter Worker Stakes Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed child under 14yrs of age on 1st January in the current year in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

Class 23 - 80cm Winter Worker Stakes Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed child under 18yrs of age on 1st January in the current year in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

Class 24 - 90cm Winter Worker Stakes Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed child under 18yrs of age on 1st January in the current year in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

Class 25 - 100cm Winter Worker Stakes Plaited or Heritage Mountain and Moorland ponies, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age but must be suitably mounted for the pony/horse they ride. An award card for the highest placed child under 25yrs of age on 1st January in the current year in each class who will also qualify for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships.

Worker Stakes Championship – 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 21 -25.
