Rules

Rules for BSPS classes as per the 2024 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook

RIHS & Blue Riband qualifying classes: - owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered to compete in classes with RIHS & Blue Riband qualification. Animals must be registered with the AHS to compete in the Anglo & Part-Bred Arab classes.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This show is a qualifier for the 2024 Royal International Horse Show (RIHS).

Refer to Rule 444 in the 2024 BSPS Handbook.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS 2024 Championship Show.

Refer to Rule 435-437in the 2024 BSPS Handbook.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS 'Blue Riband Pony of the Year'.

Refer to Rule 439 in the 2024 BSPS Handbook.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS 'Black Country Saddles' Rider of the Year.

Refer to Rule 438 in the 2024 BSPS Handbook.

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

AGES FOR RIDERS OF STALLIONS:

Riders must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion not exceeding 138cm or Small Breed M&M stallion.

Riders must be 14 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion exceeding 138cm, or any Large Breed M&M stallion.

The safety and security of persons and animals attending this show is of paramount importance to the organisers of the show. Competitors and all those attending the show are reminded of their obligations under Health & Safety legislation to adhere to the safety instructions of stewards and officials at all times, and to adhere to written instructions and signs relating to safety, for their own safety and for the safety of others who may be affected by their actions or omissions.

Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behavior of their assistants and riders, and for the conduct of such persons, and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to instructions given by judges and stewards.

Neither Area 13a committee, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, property or vehicle in connection with this show.

B.S.H.A. Classes.

This Show is held under rules of the British Show Horse Association. Owners, Riders & Horses must be registered. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

B.S.H.A RIHS Classes 1 to 4 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at the Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rules 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification. B.S.H.A RIHS Classes 5 to 11 are Qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class (Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob, Riding Horse) will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Show in September 2024. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024.

BSPA

These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday 23th July 2024. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bspaonline.com all horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate.

Competitors qualifying at this show for The Royal International Horse Show 23th-28th July 2024 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48hours of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU. Schedules and entry forms can be downloaded at http://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longgines-royal-international-horse-show/ All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA for 2024 and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor/owner/horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2024 membership of BSPA, and a RIHS qualification card. Memberships/ horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. BSPA office: 01354 638226 bspashows@gamil.com Skewbald and Piebald horse/ponies only . Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for Amateur And Junior Supreme Championship Finals to be held at BSPA World Of Colour Championship Show September 2024.. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners qualify for BSPA Star Championship at WCC.
