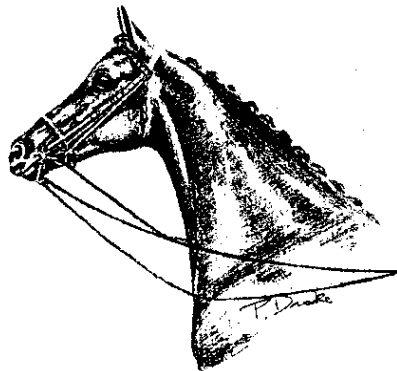

## SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS

### THIS SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER THE LATEST COVID RULES AT THE TIME OF THE SHOW

**1. HEALTH AND SAFETY.** This show is run with due regard to Health and Safety. The primary contact on the day will be Mr. C. Yates It is in the best interests of all exhibitors and spectators that they comply with any request, verbal or written, from any Show Official which pertains to Health and Safety matters. Any accident must be reported to a Show official as soon as possible. First Aiders will be on duty for all classes.

**2. Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.**

**\*\*IT IS NECESSARY ALL EXHIBITORS CARRY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR AN ADEQUATE INDEMNITY TO PROTECT AGAINST THEIR NEGLIGENCE INCLUDING ANY INJURY CAUSED BY THEIR ANIMALS OR PROPERTY.**

3. Any horse/pony which is not under complete control or in any way constitutes a danger will be asked to leave the show ground. Horses/ponies are not allowed to be ridden other than at a WALK except in the rings and working in areas.

4. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Owners/handlers are expected to clear up any dog fouling and take away

5. Neither the organizers nor the owners of the property will be responsible or liable for any loss accident or damage to any persons to their property.

6. THE DIRECTORS OF AREA 15 LIMITED RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE OR ACCEPT ENTRIES AT THEIR COMPLETE DISCRETION.

7. All horses and ponies must be 4yrs old or over

8. Only tack that is permissible in the ring in BSPS classes is allowed to be used on the show ground

9. Only horses/ponies competing at the Show are allowed on the showground.

10. No mucking out horse boxes on showground and all rubbish taken home

11. NO LUNGING ON THE SHOWGROUND

**12 HAT** - Correctly secured skull caps/riding Hats Nos.PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS), EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023. SNELL E2016 and E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006

MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either black, navy blue, brown, grey or green. Velvet covers encouraged. The BSPS encourage members to have their hats tagged through the BSPS scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards, no check of the fit or the condition is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to

ensure that the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they complete. Members/Guardians are responsible for ensuring the manufacturer's guidelines with regard to fit and replacement are followed. **Hat Tagging in BSPS classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championships, Royal International, London International Horse Show, Burghley Gold Cup and Lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club, and Pony Club,**

**This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society** competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Owners and riders must be BSPS Members before the date of the show to compete to qualify in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBBAND, RIHS (including Pretty Polly) qualifying classes and animals must be registered with the BSPS., Except for the Anglo and Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday –Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show. (see rule 20see also 522). This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championship Show

**THIS SHOW IS A QUALIFIER FOR THE R.I.H.S.** Only one pony in each of the Lead Rein Show Hunter OR Open SHP classes OR Lead Rein Class OR First Ridden class OR Open Show Pony OR Open Intermediate SRT/SH OR Mixed Height Pretty Polly Show Pony, Pretty Polly Mixed Height SHP, Pretty Polly Intermediate SRT/SH, Pretty Polly Heritage First Ridden- Lead Rein - Pretty Polly Mixed Height Heritage ridden classes - Mixed Height Show Ponies – OR Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden OR Open Heritage Ridden Classes OR Ridden Part Bred Anglo Arab classes qualifies. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first **THREE** ponies placed in each class will qualify

**THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE QUALIFIERS FOR THE BSPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS SHOW in AUGUST 2024.**

**BSPS CHALLENGE** All shows that are affiliated to the BSPS are qualifiers for the BSPS Challenge. Animals competing in the following open classes will qualify - Leading Rein and First Ridden, Open show ponies,, Open lead rein of hunter, Open show hunter ponies, Open Intermediate SH, SRT and WHP and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First, Ridden, Ridden Ponies must not have qualified for the 2024 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualifies the Horse of the Year Show 2024 it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge

**BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR** “This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year, the 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden OR Open Show Pony OR Open Show Hunter Pony Class will qualify and the 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Intermediate SRT and SH

**”BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS”** This Show is a qualifier for BSPS “The Binks Family” Champion of \_Champions” .The 1<sup>st</sup> prizewinners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden,

**BEST OF THE BEST Supreme Champion** - Final to be held at 2024 Summer Championships. To be eligible for qualification ANIMALS MUST BE REGISTERED, owned and ridden with the B.S.P.S AND must be MEMBERS OF THE RELEVANT AREA (15) to complete in the Area Championship

**BSHA CLASSES** are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry form.**

**BSHA CLASSES 15-17. 19-20, 22-23** are qualifiers for the **Royal International Horse show**. The first prizewinner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify. If the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward with the exception of BSHA Shows, where qualification will go down the line.

**BSHA RIHS AMATEUR QUALIFYING CLASSES 24-27** Are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at the RIHS . The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final with the two highest placed unqualified horses in the Maxi Cob class.

**DAY TICKETS** – Non- members may purchase up to a maximum of **2 Day and 2 Show Tickets** per Exhibitor per Horse, per Rider, per Season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working Young Rider and Open affiliated classes only **but will NOT allow entry into OPEN RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a Day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form apply online the BSHA website **[www.britishshowhorse.org](http://www.britishshowhorse.org)**

**Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections** of The Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, **Cobs** and Riding Horse classes at the same show, **on the same day and vice versa**. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sports Horse classes

**BSHA SUPREME SEASON** The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 in each **Open** Affiliated class Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cob and Riding Horse will qualify to compete in the

BSHA Supreme of Season Final. The Finals will be held at BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2024

**BSHA Amateur Home Produced Qualifier Class 28**— Owners Riders and Horses must be registered with BSHA or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Riders must be 15years of age or older. This class is a qualifier for the **Turley & Gill Family Amateur Home-Produced Supreme** Final to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. Open to horses to be Home-Produced and ridden by an Amateur; please see rule 6 & 7 in 2024 BSHA Rulebook for Amateur Home-Produced definition. Horses must be registered either a Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse. The two highest placed unqualified in the top five will qualify for the final at the BSHA National Championship Show.

**The BSHA** offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each **Open** class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Horse Ladies Show Horse and HOYS Hunter classes) Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rule 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rule book.

The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

**RIHS SPORTS HORSE BREEDING (GB) HUNTER CLASSES-** Royal International Horse Show Qualifiers. These will be judged under Sports Horse Breeding of (GB) Society's Rules. Classes 29-32 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2024 and only horses registered on the SHB(GB) Basic I.D & Show Hunter register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society.

Day Tickets=£36 This entitles competitors to compete at a maximum 2 shows in the year at £42 per show. It covers owners and riders membership together with the horse registration for the show. If the class is a qualifying class for the RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full membership and horse registration must be received by SHB(GB) office within 14 days. Amateur Hunter classes to be run under 2024 rules.

The two highest horses in classes 29-32 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. In class 29 the two highest placed smalls will qualify and the two highest placed lightweights in class 30 will qualify. The two highest placed middleweights in class 31 will qualify and the two highest placed Heavyweights in class 32 will qualify. No lower than second in its class will qualify in classes 29-32. The two highest placed Small/lightweight/middleweight/Heavyweight Hunters in Class 33 will qualify

**Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL Not be required to be possession of a JMB height Certification or Verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB(GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS or HOYS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.**

### **AMATEUR CLASSES**

a). AMATEUR OWNER/RIDER: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No professional, including Professional Grooms are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

b) AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at anytime in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Produced riders having lessons at any time with an Instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. **We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes.**
