TGCA TOYS - In Hand and Ridden Classes Show Number 24/2104/ULT– No known breeding required to enter these classes. TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is bred traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.

Rules / Condition of Entry

1. First aid in attendance so if you require this service then please see the secretary
2. All exhibitors are responsible for arriving at their classes on time – the show organisers except no responsibility for late arrivals
3. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and may at their discretion cancel, split and / or amalgamate classes
4. The judge's decision is final, and he / she may withhold any award if there is not sufficient merit and the show committee reserve the right to arrange for replacement or substitute judges if necessary
5. Any communication between competitor and the judge must be through the steward
6. No horse / rider to leave the ring without having the judge's approval
7. Any horse behaving dangerously may be asked to leave the showground
8. All stallions / colts over 3 years of age must wear a suitable bridle
9. The show excepts no responsibility for any lost, damaged or stolen items
10. No person shall be mounted on the show ground unless he / she is wearing a correctly fitted hard helmet
11. Unattended horses and ponies must not be left tied to the outside of any vehicle
12. Anybody noticing an incident of neglect or ill treatment must report it to the show secretary / steward immediately
13. All horses / ponies entering a ridden show class must be over 4 years of age
14. Numbers should be collected from the secretary's tent and will not be posted.
15. Anybody on the showground behaving in a rude, abusive or dangerous manner which is likely to compromise the health and safety and the enjoyment of the show to others will be asked to leave the showground
16. Young handlers and riders under the age of 18 years old must ensure that they are capable of handling / riding their exhibits. Age and ability must be taken into consideration when pairing exhibits and their handlers to ensure everybody is safe
17. Any person under the age of 18 must be wearing a correctly fitted riding hat when showing horses / ponies in hand
