CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By competing at the show you are agreeing to the conditions of entry.

1. The Judges decisions is final.
2. Objections must be made in writing together with a £50 deposit within half an hour of the end of the event concerned being judged. If the objection is not upheld the money will be forfeited.
3. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to Competitors, onlookers or their property, servants, horses or ponies, in connection with this Show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the promoters against any legal action from such accident.
4. The Committee reserve the right to change Judges from one event to another or to substitute Judges without due warning.
5. Classes may be cancelled, amalgamated or divided depending on numbers of entries.
6. The Organisers reserve the right to close all classes at any date if they consider sufficient entries have been received.
7. Late entries and entries on the day, will be accepted if class limit, and will be charged at the late entry fee. POST DATED CHEQUES & ENTRIES POST STAMPED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE WILL BE CHARGED LATE ENTRY FEES.
8. If for any reason the Show has to be cancelled half the entry fee only will be refunded in no other case will this be returned unless a doctors or vets certificate is sent to the Show Secretary.
9. Any prizes not collected by the end of the show will be forfeited.
10. **No hay nets to be used outside of Lorries or trailers. No animals to be tied to Lorries or trailers.**
11. All animals entered for this show must hold a current Flu Vaccine certificate, random inspections may be held.
12. Any animal taking part in classes judged under rules will be liable to dope testing.
13. In the interests of safety, a Horse or Pony, whether ridden or in Hand, should be moved at a walk, except in showing rings or designated exercise areas. Exhibitors disregarding this rule may be asked to leave the showground and entries forfeited. Hard hats must be worn at all times when riding anywhere on the showground.
14. Competitors must be ready 15 minutes before the commencement of all timed classes. We regret that due to the tight schedule, it will not be possible to delay any class, while competitors or animals perform in another ring. Every effort will be made by the organizers to run to the approximate times displayed. Entry into any ring late will be at the judge's discretion.
15. The show committee reserve the right to refuse entry from any persons and reserve the right to ask persons to leave the showground
16. **ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED IF ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS ARE NOT FORWARD FOR THE JUDGING OF THE SUPREME HORSE / PONY CHAMPIONSHIP.**

RING ONE – THURSDAY 4TH APRIL

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION AMATEUR CLASSES

Classes 1 - 4 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at the Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rules 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

- Class 1 **BSHA AMATEUR RIDING HORSE – RIHS.** Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms, 4 years old or over. Open to horses owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).
- Class 2 **BSHA AMATEUR COBS – RIHS.** Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4 years old or over. Open to Cobs owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).
- Class 3 **BSHA AMATEUR HACK – RIHS.** Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms, 4 years old or over. Open to horses owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).
- Class 4 **BSHA AMATEUR MAXI COBS RIHS.** Mare or gelding exceeding 155cms, 4 years old or over. Open to Cobs owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).

AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 1 – 4 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

- Class 5 **TATTERSALLS ROR NOVICE RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2024**
 Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any height, must have raced in GB and have current RoR Competition Membership. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses will be ridden by the Judge and will be stripped for conformation assessment. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes are NOT ignored in this series. **The first three go forward to the Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships Aintree, August 24th 2024. To take part in this class, horses must NOT have won:** a ridden open class under any affiliated showing society including (inc SEIB/HOYS, BSHA, SHB(GB) BSPS, BSPA, Tattersalls RoR Open / Amateur Ridden Show Series Qualifier, TARRA Ridden, or any other open class **except** Tattersalls RoR Challenge Show Series, other Working Hunter type classes or In Hand classes. Unaffiliated Show wins are not considered.
Prizes: RoR rosettes 1st - 4th and a RoR branded prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

- Class 6 **OPEN RIDDEN THOROUGHBREDS.** Thoroughbred mare or gelding, four years old or over, any height.

THOROUGHBRED CHAMPIONSHIP 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 5 – 6 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION CLASSES

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.** Classes 10 - 16 are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Season Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Show in September 2024.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and HOYS Hunter classes. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year. Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024.

Novice classes are for horses which has not won a first prize of £25 or more, or more than a total of £150 (including championship prize money) in any showing classes, excluding; Working Show Horse, Best Trained, Pairs, Side-Saddle, or In Hand which were affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to the 1st January 2024. If the category has changed from a Hack to Riding Horse or vice versa, it may not revert back to a novice. Winnings gained as a four year old are exempt unless that four year old won an open ridden class with a first prize of £25 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.

Class 7 **BSHA NOVICE RIDING HORSE**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms, four years old or over. Please see rule 6D in BSHA Rulebook 2024.

Class 8 **BSHA NOVICE COB / MAXI COB**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms, four years old or over. Please see rule 6D in BSHA Rulebook 2024.

Class 9 **BSHA NOVICE HACK**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms, four years old or over. Please see rule 6D in BSHA Rulebook 2024.

NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 7 – 9 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

Class 10 **BSHA SMALL RIDING HORSE - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms, four years old or over.

Class 11 **BSHA LARGE RIDING HORSE - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 158cms, four years old or over.

RIDING HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd Prize winners in classes 10 – 11 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

Class 12 **BSHA LIGHTWEIGHT COB - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying up to 14 stone.

Class 13 **BSHA HEAVYWEIGHT RIDING COB - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying more than 14 stone.

RIHS COB CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 12 – 13 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

Class 14 **BSHA SMALL HACK - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms, four years old or over.

Class 15 **BSHA LARGE HACK - RIHS**. Mare or gelding exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms, four years old or over.

HACK CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 14 – 15 to compete. Champion to qualify for the *Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

Class 16 **BSHA MAXI COB - RIHS**. Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 155cms. To be judged as a Cob. All Maxi Cobs should be shown hogged. Winner qualifies for *The Veronica White £1,000 Supreme*.

RING TWO – THURSDAY 4TH APRIL

Class 17 **TATTERSALLS ROR FORMER RACEHORSE CHALLENGE 2024**

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be Competition Registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB or been IN TRAINING in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. **The first four go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree, August 24th 2024.** The Judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the Judge. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. The class to be judged **50%** jumping, **20%** Style while jumping and performance and **30%** awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

PHASE 1

Jumping to be judged: 8 rustic jumps 3 foot (90cm) to 3 foot 3 inches (1m) with a maximum spread of 95 centimeters). The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round: 10 points to be deducted for a knock down, 15 points to be deducted for a refusal, 20 points for second refusal. Elimination for third refusal or fall or Error of Course.

PHASE 2

Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. (*In some classes, at the Judge's discretion, horses might be asked to do a 'show' following their jumping without leaving the ring. This is often the case with a large number in the class*). Each horse to complete an individual show of no longer than 1 ½ minutes. Show to include the following movements: walk, trot, canter showing change of leg, extended canter (gallop) halt and stand, walk off on long rein. Total marks out of **30%** for Show, manners and suitability to be retrained. Fences for the final at Aintree can be up to a maximum of 3'6" (1.05m).

Prizes: Rosettes 1st – 4th and a RoR branded prize to the winner. A branded prize to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification for the RoR Ridden Veteran Final also at Aintree on 24th August 2024. Prizes to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Class 18 **BSHA SEIB OPEN WORKING SHOW HORSE - RIHS** qualifier for the Open Working Show Horse Championship at The Royal International Horse Show. All affiliated BSHA Open Working Show Horse classes are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show final and the SEIB Working Show Horse Final. For the RIHS qualification, the winner, if not already qualified in the Working Show Horse class will qualify. If the first has already qualified, the qualification may pass down to no lower than fifth place. For the SEIB Working Show Horse qualification, the two highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify. Qualifying classes held after the Royal International Horse Show and the BSHA National Championships in the current season will carry the qualification forward to the next season but only the WINNER will receive qualification in these cases. **Open ONLY to Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms.** This class is **NOT** open to Hunters, i.e. those horses registered and competing as a hunter or working hunter with BSHA, Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain or The Showing Register for the current season. Please refer to rule 12(iv)(i) in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Working Show Horse qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification. Any Horse which is a Grade B Showjumper, Intermediate Eventer, or above, as at the 1st January of the current year, is not eligible to compete in any Working Show Horse class. A Rider may ride up to two Horses in the jumping phase but must then select one Horse to take through to the Ride and Conformation

phases (if required). No change of Rider is allowed. Winner to qualify for the **Veronica White £1,000 Supreme**

Class 19 **UNAFFILIATED NOVICE WORKING HUNTER**. Open to mares and geldings exceeding 148cms 4 years and over not to have won a first prize of £25 or more in a working hunter class prior to January 2024. Jumps approximately 3'0".

RIHS WORKING HUNTERS – KINDLY SPONSORED BY MOBILETHRONES

Fences will be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 in number and a maximum height of 1.14m (3ft 9ins) at the discretion of the Judge. No change of tack or rider is allowed except if a side-saddle is used, then the saddle may be changed for the Judge. No change of tack or rider is allowed except if a side-saddle is used, then the saddle may be changed for the Judges ride. Exhibitors can now enter up to two horses in a Working Hunter class but following the jumping phase it will be up to the exhibitor to select only one horse to take forward into the ridden & conformation section if required. A skullcap or hard hat with safety harness and navy or black cover must be worn to current approved BSI or European standards during the jumping phase. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. Horses displaying continued disobedience, or horses leaving the ring mounted or dismounted will be eliminated. Horses with minus scores may not be required for the second phase of the class at the discretion of the judge. Under no circumstances should a horse with a minus score be in a qualifying position. 40 points are awarded for Ride/Manners and Conformation.

Class 20 **SHB(GB) WORKING HUNTER – RIHS**. Stallion, mare or gelding (stallions to wear a red, white & blue ribbon displayed in their tail), 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms, Grade A showjumpers and advanced eventers are not eligible to compete in this class. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A showjumper or advanced event horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working hunter classes. Winner to qualify for the **Veronica White £1,000 Supreme**.

Class 21 **TRAINING STAKES** – Animals 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 60cms.

Class 22 **BSPS NURSERY STAKES** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Minimum height of fences: 60cms, maximum height of fences 75cms.

Class 23 **NOVICE MIXED HEIGHT WHP** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must jump in the correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal that they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 25 **BSPS WORKING HUNTER PONY 143CMS** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences: 100cms.

Class 26 **BSPS WORKING HUNTER PONY 153CMS** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 145cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences: 105cms.

BSPS WHP CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 24 – 26 to compete. Champion to qualify for the **Veronica White £1,000 Supreme**.

SPORT HORSE BREEDING (GB)

All Hunter classes will be judged under the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain Rules 2024. Only horses registered on the current year's Show Hunter register are eligible to enter classes 27-30 and 32-36 and Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be full members of the society. Classes 27-30 and 32-36 can be registered on a **Day Ticket = £42** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £42 per show– it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: Competitors must wear a skull cap or hat with safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard at all times. Skull caps must have a navy blue or black cover. The two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Amateur Hunter Classes, the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.

Classes 27-30 and 32-36 ARE QUALIFIERS FOR THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW. (Entry fee includes £11.00 levy to RIHS)

Class 27 **SHB(GB) NOVICE HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER.** Mare or gelding four years old and over, not having won a first prize of £25 or a total of £150 (or equivalent values) in prize money (***including championship prize money***) in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad, before 1st January in the current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old. ***4 year olds will be ridden by a ride judge in these classes. An SHB(GB) special award will be made to the highest placed 4 year old in a Novice class.***

NOVICE HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 27 – 28 to compete. Champion to qualify for the ***Veronica White £1,000 Supreme.***

Class 29 **SHB(GB) AMATEUR LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER – RIHS.** Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12 stone 7 lbs) and under. Small hunters to be included in this category. To be ridden by an amateur (as defined by SHB (GB) 2024 rules). **The two highest placed LWTs and the two highest placed Small will qualify.**

Class 30 **SHB(GB) AMATEUR HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER – RIHS.** Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying over 79.5kgs (12 stone 7 lbs). Middleweight hunters to be included in this category. To be ridden by an amateur (as defined by SHB (GB) 2024 rules). **The two highest placed MWTs and the two highest placed HWTs will qualify.**
