- **ENTRIES CLOSE** 15th March 2024, late entries will be taken after this date at a premium
- **ROSETTES** awarded to 6th place in all classes
- **STABLING** is available on Friday 29th March and Saturday 30th March evening at £70 per night (bedding is provided however, if you would like to bring more of your own, you must only use shavings. All stables can be booked when making entries to the show.
- **HATS** – It is strongly recommended that riders aged 18 years and over wear a correctly fitted safety hat to the below standard: All PAS 015: VG1: ASTM F1163 04a onwards: SNELL E2001: AS/NZS 3838 2003onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. Skull caps must have a navy blue or black cover.
- **SHOW RULES** – For all show rules please refer to the official Wiltshire Show Rule Book which is on the website – www.wiltshireshow.co.uk
- **CHAMPIONSHIPS** – all championships will take place at the end of each section.

RIHS AMATEUR QUALIFYING CLASSES

Classes 19-22 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rules 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

Judge: Mrs W King (C) & Miss S Chapman (R)

Class 19 BSHA Amateur Cobs – RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4years old & over. Open to cobs owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).

Class 20 BSHA Amateur Maxi Cobs – RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 155cms, 4 years old & over. Open to cobs owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).

Class 21 BSHA Amateur Riding Horse – RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms, 4 years old & over. Open to horses owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).

Class 22 BSHA Amateur Hack – RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms, 4 years old & over. Open to horses owned and ridden by an amateur (the rider need not be the owner of the horse).

open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 19 – 22

SIDE SADDLE ASSOCIATION CLASSES

The following classes are affiliated to the Side Saddle Association, please ensure you families yourself with the societies rulebook

Judge: Miss R Catterall

Class 23 SSA Open Equitation – open to Adults and Juniors. If entries warrant, an Open Class may be divided into an Adult and a Junior Class at the discretion of the Show. SSA Rosettes and Qualifying Points shall be awarded to Adults & Juniors as 2 sections: the highest placed Adult & Junior Members will receive SSA rosettes to 3rd place, and Qualifying Points down each line. The highest placed Member under 14 on 1st January of the current year will receive a rosette. All competitors must wear hats to current Safety Standards or above.

Class 24 SSA Classical Ladies Side Saddle – Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. NB Silks Hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges must use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs T Mitchell & Mr L Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already qualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only. The four highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not ex 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. SSA Members who qualify for The Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship Classes.

Class 25 SSA Concours D'Elegance – The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors must wear hats to current Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk

open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 23-25

Classes 26-34 & 37 are all unaffiliated and do not require membership to any society, however classes 35 & 36 are affiliated to CHAPS (UK) which also do not require membership to compete in these classes, however, should you wish to qualify for the CHAPS (UK) championship you must be a member of CHAPS (UK)

Class 26 Open Ridden Cobs / Maxi Cobs – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed.

Class 27 Open Riding Horses – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms.

Class 28 Open Ridden Hacks – mare or gelding 4 years & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms.

Judge Miss S Chapman

Class 29 First Season Show Horse – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be competing in their first season of showing.

Class 30 Restricted Show Horse – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Not to have qualified for the RIHS or HOYS.

Class 31 Local Show Horse – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be kept within a 25 mile radius of the show venue.

Class 32 Ridden M&M excluding Welsh – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest & Shetland Stud Books.

Class 33 Ridden Welsh – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society.

Class 34 Ridden Veteran – stallion, mare or gelding, 15 years old & over. Any height or type.

Class 35 CHAPS Ridden Coloured Native / Cob / Traditional – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Any height. This class is affiliated to CHAPS.

Class 36 CHAPS Ridden Coloured Plaited – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Any height. This class is affiliated to CHAPS.

Class 37 Ridden Pure & Part Bred Irish Draught – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Any height.

RIHS BSPA RIDDEN CLASSES

The following classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead July 2024. Classes will be judged under BSPA Rules. Download from www.bspaonline.com. All horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and Riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider's age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate before entry into the RIHS 2024. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA Showing Permit (contact BSPA for Stallion showing permit information) for 2024 and have a BSPA stallion ID card and wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2024 Membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. Highest placed Amateur and highest placed Junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championships Final to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2024. RIHS AMATEUR HUNTER CLASSES

All Hunter classes will be judged under the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain Rules 2024. Only horses registered on the current year's Show Hunter register are eligible to enter classes 42-43 and 50-54. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be full members of the society. Classes 42-43 and 50-54 can be registered on a Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show's in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: Competitors must wear a skull cap or hat with safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard at all times. Skull caps must have a navy blue or black cover. The two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Amateur Hunter Classes, the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify, and Classes 42, 43, 50, 51, 52, 53 & 54 ARE QUALIFIERS FOR THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW.

The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward, with the exception of BSHA shows, where qualification will go down the line. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse, Racehorse to Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024.

Please note the height of the fences may be raised at the final at the discretion of the Course builder/ BSHA Representative.

Class 73 Intermediate Working Hunter Horse 95cm – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms

Class 74 TATTERSALLS ROR FORMER RACEHORSE CHALLENGE SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2024 Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree 2024 The judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'. The class to be judged 50% jumping, 20% Style while jumping and performance and 30% awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained. Voucher for a RoR branded prize to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final at Aintree on 24th August 2024.

Open to thoroughbred and Arab horses, retired from race training. highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Racehorse to Show Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. This class is open to competitors who work within the racing industry. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 113 Small and Large Hack: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 160cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Hack Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 114 Rising Star Ladies Show Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms, suitable to carry a side saddle, to be ridden side saddle by a lady. Open to all Hacks, Cobs, Riding Horses and Hunters. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Ladies Show Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December.

Class 115 Rising Star Small Riding Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Supreme Small Riding Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 116 Large Riding Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Large Riding Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 117 Novice Ex Racehorse – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over.

Class 118 Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024. Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23rd 2024 RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024. Voucher for a RoR branded prize to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final at Aintree on 24th August 2024

Class 119 Tattersalls RoR Open Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024. Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The first THREE go forward to the championship at Hickstead on June 23rd, 2024. All entries MUST be competition registered with the RoR and include their competition registration number on entry form and have RACED in GB. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force' Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horse's last run in a race (NH or Flat) or will provide 2 ride judges should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series. Voucher for a RoR branded prize to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final at Aintree on 24th August 2024. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Heavyweight Cob Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 122 LIHS Rising Star Maxi Cob: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms - to be judged as Cobs. Judges must pay particular attention to type (i.e. short legged animals of COB type). To be shown hogged. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Maxi Cob Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.
